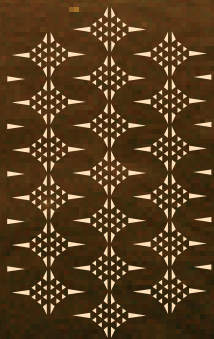




 **red flower** hammam
